The PTS Sepsis Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with sepsis.



Amputee

The purpose of our Amputee Program is to provide each candidate with individualized treatment, education and monitoring of each resident with an amputation and to foster return to highest level of function.



Seating Program Guidelines

Our seating program provides an interdisciplinary approach for each residents unique needs. Treatment and education provide specific adaptations or custom seating to those residents determined appropriate.



Urinary Tract Infection

The PTS UTI Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with a Urinary Tract Infection (UTI).



Cardiac

Our Cardiac Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with cardiac disease.



Dementia

Our Dementia Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with dementia related diagnosis and to ensure that all residents identified as having a dementia diagnosis are functioning at their optimal physical and cognitive abilities. Residents who have a dementia or dementia related diagnosis, as well as Alzheimer's disease would most benefit from this comprehensive program.



Falls

Our Fall Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with increased risk for falls or with a history of falls.



Rhythmic Auditory Stimulation

The purpose of our Rhythmic Auditory Stimulation Program is to optimize physical capabilities in residents through the use of auditory stimulation to facilitate motor movement, specifically targeting functional transfers and gait with the goal of reducing the need for chair and personal alarms ultimately reducing overall fall risk.



Heart Failure

The PTS Heart Failure Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with Heart Failure.



Wound Management

The purpose of our Wound Management Program is to provide individualized treatment, education and monitoring to residents with a Stage III or Stage IV non healing wound where treatment is not contraindicated.



Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)

The PTS COPD Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD). Residents who have a COPD diagnosis or a related diagnosis such as Bronchitis or Emphysema would most benefit from this comprehensive program.



Pneumonia

Our Pneumonia Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with pulmonary disease.



Pulmonary

Our Pulmonary Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with pulmonary disease.



Parkinson's Disease

Our Parkinson's Disease Program is an interdisciplinary approach for the education, treatment and monitoring of residents with Parkinson's Disease (PD) or Parkinson's Plus Syndrome (PPS).



Contracture Management

Our Contracture Management Program is an interdisciplinary approach for residents to achieve optimal range of motion and positioning in order to facilitate their highest level of function.

The purpose of our ADL Program is ensure that all residents are performing their ADLs to their highest level of independence and that all caregivers for those residents are knowledgeable of the resident specific ADL program.
